

There are five clubs in Wayne County; three in Richmond, one in Pershing and one in Hagerstown. We were able to visit all five clinics.


Staff and providers of Neighborhood Health Center taught club members about Medical Assisting. Club members were able to get hands on experience with tools used by Medical Assistants.
